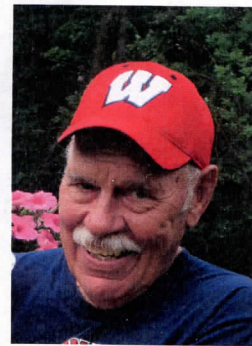


# Raymond E. Phillippi



Raymond E. Phillippi, age 84, of Pittsville, WI died Wednesday, Dec. 16, 2015 at Ministry St. Joseph's Hospital, Marshfield, WI.
